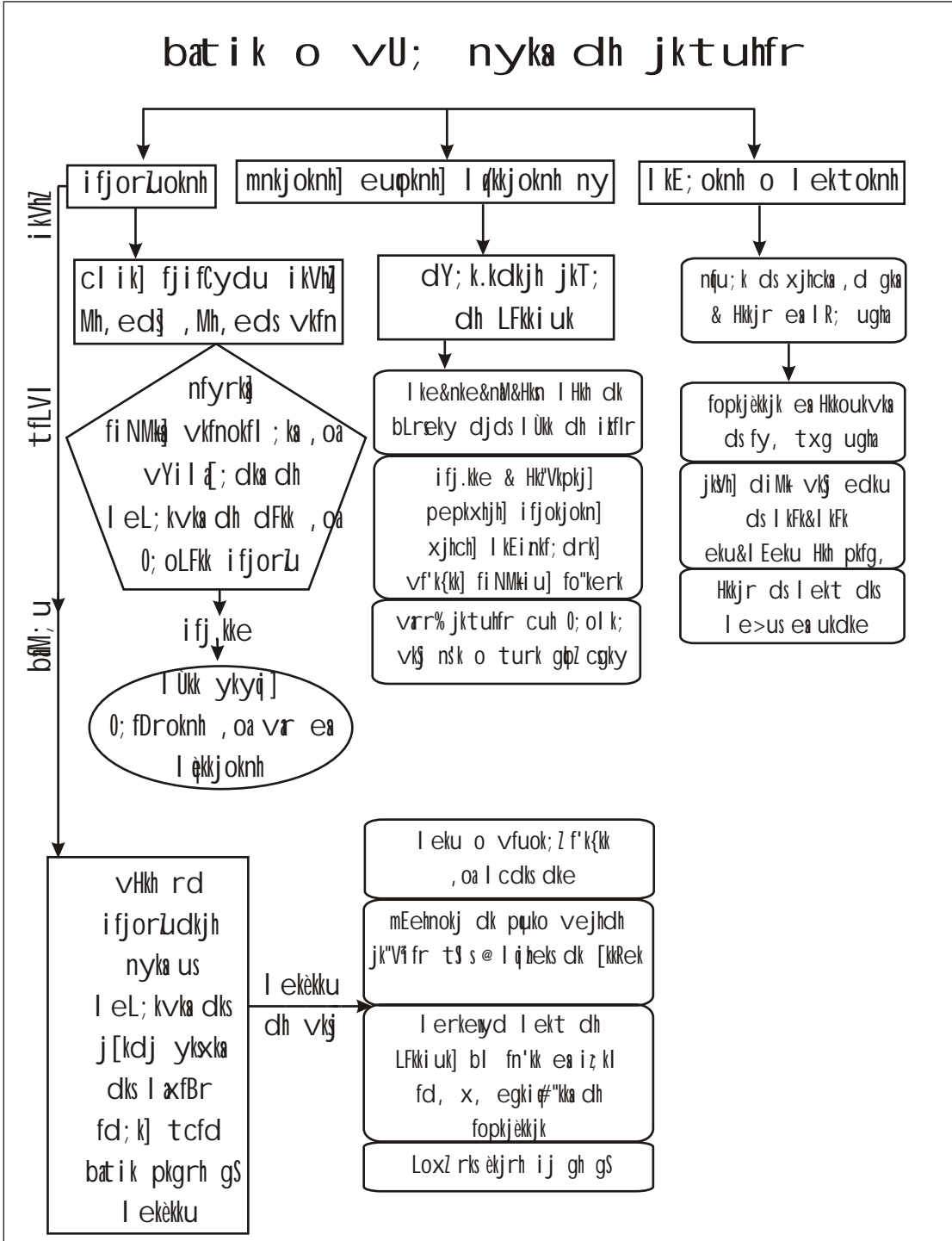
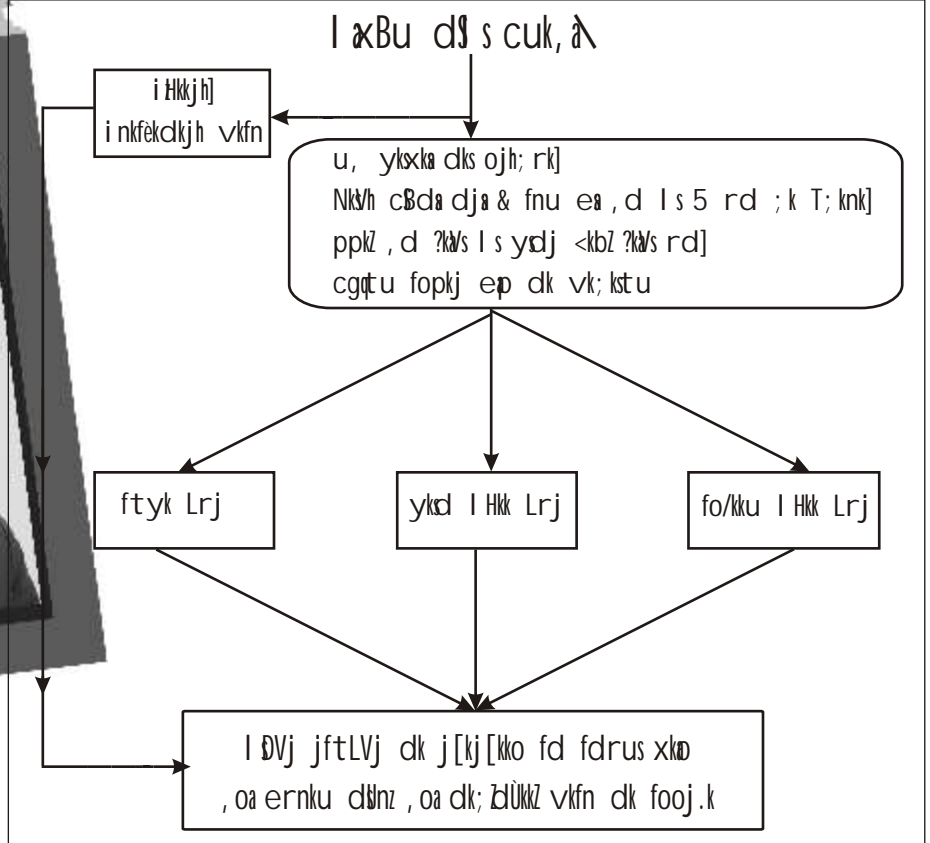

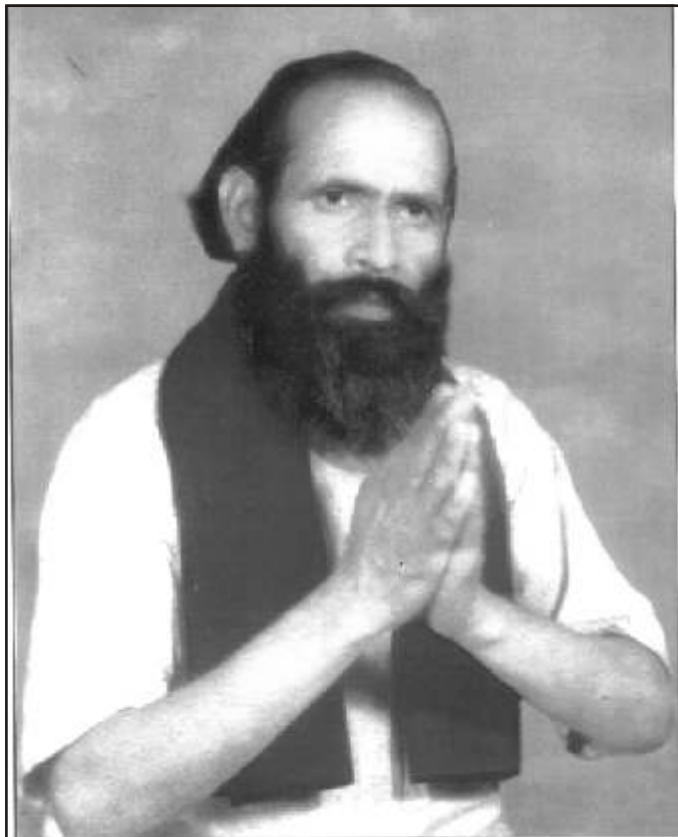

INDIA SHOULD FOLLOW NEPAL ON CASTE DISCRIMINATION

New Delhi, September 29, 09.
Dr. Udit Raj, Chairman of the All India Confederation of SC/ST Organizations, congratulated Nepal Minister, Jeet Bahadur Darjee Gautam who welcomed the idea of United Human Rights Commission to include caste discrimination in the draft Principles and Guidelines published four months back. Dr. Udit Raj said that in the year 2001, United Nations had a World Conference against racism, racial discrimination and xenophobia. Lots of Dalit organizations participated in the Conference and the matter got sensitized. The Conference began from 31 August till 8th September, 2001, and hectic lobbying with NGOs and organizations of other countries including participation by Governments was done and as a result, the Human Rights Commission acknowledged the caste

discrimination so that it could be eliminated with global effort. The Government of India at that time had opposed it on the ground that there was no discrimination in India on caste lines. The present Chief Minister of Jammu & Kashmir who was at that time External Affairs Minister in the Government of India opposed in the Conference that the Indian Constitution does not allow discrimination on caste lines. What a poor argument was offered, says Dr. Udit Raj. In spite of Government of India's opposition, the caste discrimination was accepted but under a different terminology "discrimination based on work and descent". Dr. Udit Raj questions as to how is it possible to hide such a big issue when there is a revolution in communication. Durban Conference review was done from 20th to 24th April, 2009, in Geneva. Unfortunately, caste

discrimination was not discussed but support from the Nepal Government now will facilitate the issue. It seems that Nepal Government is quite realistic and influence of communism cannot be undermined. This is a courageous stand and if the Nepal Government follows such courageous policies on the domestic front, a day will come when it will leave India behind. Unfortunately, both the BJP and the Congress Parties are together on this issue and are very keen that it should not be globalized. Their intention is not to do away with the caste system. Caste perpetuation will ultimately hamper the overall development of the country. The All India Confederation of SC/ST Organizations has decided to wage a struggle in this regard so that Government of India should not block it.

ALLAHABAD HIGH COURT HAS SOUGHT A REPORT FROM PRADESH GOVERNMENT ON THE MURDER OF BHADUR SONKAR

New Delhi, September 23, 09.
Udit Raj, National President, Indian Justice Party, said that Shri Bahadur Sonkar, who was an Indian Justice Party candidate for the Jaunpur Lok Sabha constituency, was murdered on 13th April, 2009, and after an enquiry into the matter, the Uttar Pradesh Government, wrongly termed it as a case of suicide. Under these circumstances, the Indian Justice Party decided to knock at the doors of the Allahabad High Court. Our petition in this matter was

heard in the Allahabad High Court on May 29, 2009, and the Uttar Pradesh Government was directed to ask the Home Secretary of the State Government to hold a fresh enquiry and complete in a month's time. When the UP Government did not complete the enquiry within the stipulated period, the Indian Justice Party again knocked at the doors of the Allahabad High Court.
A two-judge bench of the Allahabad High Court consisting of Hon'ble Justice Ravindra Singh and Hon'ble

Justice Yogesh Chandra Gupta, heard the matter again on 16.9.2009, and directed the Uttar Pradesh Government to file an affidavit in the Court about the progress of the matter by 12.10.2009. Senior Advocate Shri P.M.N. Singh and his other colleagues, Shri Afzal Durrani and Shri Jamal Khan argued before the Hon'ble Court that they were not expecting any justice from the State Government and as such orders may be issued for holding a CBI enquiry into the matter. ***

UN set to treat caste as human rights violation

NEW DELHI: If the recent genome study denying the Aryan-Dravidian divide has established the antiquity of caste segregations in marriage, the ongoing session of the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva looks set to recognize caste-based discrimination as a human rights violation. This, despite India's opposition and following Nepal's breaking ranks on the culturally sensitive issue.

Nepal has emerged as the first country from South Asia -- the region where untouchability has been traditionally practiced -- to declare support for the draft principles and guidelines published by UNHRC four months ago for "effective elimination of discrimination based on work and descent" -- the UN terminology for caste inequities.

In a side-event to the session on September 16, Nepalese minister Jeet Bahadur Darjee Gautam said his county welcomed the idea mooted by the UNHRC document to involve "regional and international mechanism, the UN and its organs" to complement national efforts to combat caste discrimination. This is radically different from India's stated aversion to the internationalization of the caste problem.

Much to India's embarrassment, Nepal's statement evoked an immediate endorsement from the office of the UN high commissioner for human rights, Navanethem Pillay, a South African Tamil. Besides calling Nepal's support "a significant step by a country grappling with this entrenched problem itself", Pillay's office said it would "like to encourage other states to follow this commendable example".

The reference to

India was unmistakable especially since Pillay had pressed the issue during her visit to New Delhi in March. Pillay not only asked India to address "its own challenges nationally, but show leadership in combating caste-based discrimination globally". The granddaughter of an indentured labourer taken to South Africa from a village near Madurai, Pillay recalled that in 2006, Prime Minister Manmohan Singh had compared untouchability to apartheid. Adding to India's discomfiture, Sweden, in its capacity as the president of the European Union, said, "caste-based discrimination and other forms of discrimination based on work and descent is an important priority for EU". If this issue continues to gather momentum, UNHRC may in a future session adopt the draft principles and guidelines and, to impart greater legal force, send them for adoption to the UN General Assembly.

The draft principles specifically cited caste as one of the grounds on which more than 200 million people in the world suffer discrimination. "This type of discrimination is typically associated with the notion of purity and pollution and practices of untouchability, and is deeply rooted in societies and cultures where this discrimination is practiced," it said.

Though India succeeded in its efforts to keep caste out of the resolution adopted by the 2001 Durban conference on racism, the issue has since re-emerged in a different guise, without getting drawn into the debate over where caste and race are analogous.

Only in 2003, Government of India woke up to the occasion to buy this place from a private owner.

Dr. Indresh Gajive, National Coordinator of the Committee said that the places related to Dr. Ambedkar like his birth place at Mhow Indore, MP, Diksha Bhoomi - Nagpur and Chaitya Bhoomi - Mumbai, are commemorated every year on a particular date where lakhs of followers assemble and pay their homage. It is important to mention that Mhow which is the birth place of Dr. Ambedkar is commemorated every year by the State Govt. at its expense where more than 5 lakh Buddhists and followers participate and pay their respects. The occasion is also known as Dalit Mahakumbh on his birth anniversary i.e. 14th April, every year.

Dr. Udit Raj, National Advisor of the Committee, said that even though 26, Alipore Road is declared by

the govt. as a monument yet no activities are done on its part, nor are they being encouraged. The place is in such a pathetic condition that animals roam around and it is full of dirt. He further said that had Government given due attention, by now this place would have been known as one of the holiest places in the country. The Committee is now determined to struggle to restore due importance to the place. On the 6th of December, 2009, lakhs of people will assemble at the place where Dr. Ambedkar received Mahaparinirvan so that this place also becomes like Diksha Bhoomi in the years to come. We are constrained to resort to this action because Government had been ignoring our demand in the past. To awaken the government, a big meeting was organized in 2007, and a Memorandum was submitted to the

President and the Prime Minister of India but, so far, no action has been taken in this direction.

Shri T.M. Kumar, National Convenor of the Committee said that the only Dalit representative at the Round Table Conference was Dr. Ambedkar. On his demand, right of separate electorate was granted to Dalits which was opposed by Mahatma Gandhi and that finally culminated into Poona Pact and reservation was its byproduct. He said that Dr. Ambedkar could visualize that Dalit representation through general electorate will make them ineffective and it is precisely happening now and, therefore, it is again being demanded that there should be separate Dalit electorate. He further said that the Committee strongly feels that caste certificate of one state should be valid for jobs in other States. In the absence

of this, lakhs of posts are lying vacant and eligible candidates are becoming unemployed. The presidential order of 1950 should be revoked so that caste certificate of one state is valid all over the country.

Dalit leaders like Ms Mayawati should have been active much before in restoring due respect to this place. However, this has not been done. The Committee urges her not only to support the cause morally and financially but to make her presence on the 6th December, 2009. With a view to make Ambedkar Shradhajali Mela and Dalit Maha Panchayat a grand success, a preparatory meeting will be held on 25th October, 2009 at Dr. Ambedkar Bhawan, New Delhi to discuss and finalize the programme and make it a grand success.

Confederation Activities To Be Intensified A month long dharna to be staged instead of a day long rally

National Convention of the All India Confederation of SC/ST Organizations was held on 8th and 9th August, 2009, at Dr. Ambedkar Bhawan, New Delhi, which was most successful. It was resolved in this convention that instead of holding a rally like the previous years, this time we should hold a month-long Dharna at Jantar Mantar at New Delhi on the burning issues including reservation in private sector. This will help in starting a new movement at the national level. There are twenty-eight States in the country and the Confederation has its units in most of the States. Each State unit will be assigned to have one day long Dharna. The larger departments and

organizations like strong district units can sit on Dharna for one day on their own strength.

Each State has to mobilize Members of Parliament, Members of Legislative Assemblies and other important leaders to address Dharna at Jantar Mantar on their day. In this way, not only people's representatives will be educated about our issues but we shall get their support to strengthen our movement. It is not an easy task to organize for a month. You are aware that for organizing a dharna, a lot of effort, time and money are required for its success. For this one has to burn mid-night's oil and a lot of money is also required. During the

convention held on 8th and 9th August, 2009, I made a special request to some of the members to make personal contribution to make the movement successful and most of them did it.
